Kitikmeot Inuit Association President Recognized for Efforts to Build the NRC

The Kitikmeot Inuit Association's Annual General Meeting, held in Cambridge Bay on October 5th, 2010, provided a perfect opportunity for the KIA Board of Directors and KIA Elders to recognize the achievements of one of their own. KIA President, Charlie Evalik, was honoured with a Special Recognition Award for his efforts over the past year to create the Nunavut Resources Corporation (NRC). In his acceptance speech, President Evalik, who also is Chairman of the NRC, noted that the NRC would not have got off the ground had it not received crucial financial support from a variety of agencies, including INAC's Major Resource and Energy Development Program, the Canadian Northern Economic Development Agency, the Government of Nunavut and Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated (NTI). President Evalik also recognized the substantial investment that the KIA itself has made to the NRC, both in terms of financial and staff resources. The establishment of an NRC Advisory Committee, composed of representatives from NTI and the Regional Inuit Associations, was also noted as a recent success. President Evalik concluded his remarks by thanking the audience and by emphasizing the fact that the NRC will be a unique

vehicle to allow the Inuit of Nunavut to achieve more meaningful economic participation in major resource developments throughout Nunavut, including those located on Inuit Owned Land.

NRC to Benefit from an Inuit Advisory Committee and Experienced Board of Directors

NRC Chairman, Charlie Evalik, is very pleased to have the active participation of Inuit leadership who will sit as an Advisory Committee to the NRC Board of Directors. "The NRC will certainly benefit from the guidance that the committee will be able to provide and it will help to align the NRC's activities with the values of Nunavummiut."

Chairman Evalik also welcomes some talented and experienced

senior business leaders to the NRC's Board of Directors. In particular, he acknowledges the kind participation of the Honourable Peter Lougheed, who is serving as the NRC's senior legal counsel. The NRC Board of Directors is also joined by David Elliot, Vice President and Director of Haywood Securities Inc., one of Canada's leading institutions for financing mining developments. Mr. Scott Northey, a

financial expert with considerable knowledge in financing major capital projects in the Canadian north has also recently joined the NRC Board.

Chairman Evalik is enthusiastic about the NRC Board's initial composition, "Our Directors are among the nation's best and this will help to ensure that the NRC is wisely guided through the crucial early stages."

- Provide Inuit with opportunities to own and manage the natural resources of Nunavut
- Create a more stable local and territorial economic future through the development of a capital investment base

- Provide a basis for senior Canadian financial and investment managers to work together with Inuit
- Provide an Inuit voice at the senior corporate level
- Influence the pace and nature of development in Nunavut
